



Netball WBOP Zone Regulations

The Netball Waikato Bay of Plenty (WBOP) Zone Regulations are currently under review after a period of Netball WBOP Zone operating under the administration of Netball New Zealand (NNZ).

While the regulations review process is underway, **the Netball WBOP Zone Board adopts the rules and policies of the NNZ Regulations**, which can be viewed [here](#), with the following variances:

Rule 2. Place of Netball WBOP Zone Registered Office

The place of the registered office shall be at the University of Waikato Property Services Building, Gate 3a, 209 Te Koorama Place, Hamilton 3216, or such other place as may be notified in writing members from time to time.

Rule 7. Membership Fees

In addition to NNZ Fees, Netball WBOP Zone Fees are payable by all Netball Centres for the period 1 December 2025 – 30 November 2026. The Netball WBOP Zone Fees will be determined by the Board and notified annually to Netball Centres.

Rule 8. Netball WBOP Zone Life Membership and Service Awards

There shall be a Netball WBOP Zone Life Membership and Service Award Committee established, which functions are to (i) consider nominations and make recommendations of persons it considers should be granted a service award of Netball WBOP Zone; and (ii) consider nominations and make recommendations to the Council of persons it considers should be granted Life Membership of Netball WBOP Zone.

Rule 11. Financial Year

The financial year of Netball WBOP Zone shall commence on the 1st of December and end on the 30th day of November in the next year.

14. Colours & Logos

The predominant colours of Netball WBOP Zone are navy, red, yellow, and black. From time-to-time Netball WBOP Zone may include other colours to meet various requirements, commercial, differentiation of teams, or other such purposes as may be required. Netball WBOP Zone colours, logos and brands are set out in the Netball WBOP Zone Brand Guidelines.
