Centre Coach Coordinators Role:



- Be knowledgeable about the NNZ CD pathway
- Liaise and plan with CD officer on CD opportunities for centre preseason, completing the CD Plan
- Regularly communicate with the centre and Zone (ie: check emails)
- Actively promote CD workshop and module flyers at the centre or via email
- Be the centre contact for coach enquiries and workshop registrations
- Be available on workshop nights to collect money & help set up venue if required
- Provide CD officer with confirmed coach numbers prior to workshop

- Email copy will be sent out so Centres can upload to their website

How do we plan Coach Development for our Centre?

As the Coach Coordinator for your centre, consider the needs of your coaches and what will help build their confidence and knowledge of the art of coaching. What are your Coach strength's and weaknesses in your centre? Are you planning for the future?

Your new coaches will require support with foundation and community coach workshops but coaches who have already done their CCA award will may need access to more developing modules and don't forget to consider your representative coaches also. As outlined by the NNZ Coach Development Framework, rep coaches should have their CCA or be working towards it during that rep season and be completing further coach development opportunities.

The workshops and modules can be facilitated during the day or night to meet the needs of your coaches e.g. can be carried out during the day or in the evening. You can also consider running them in the weekend as a cluster e.g. one of the workshops on a Friday, 2 on Saturday and 2 Sunday or spread them out over the season having a 2-3 week break in between each module to give coaches time to practice their learning's.

The end of the season and pre-season is an excellent time for coaches to work through these workshops and modules but running them during the season is a great way to support coaches as they coach their teams.

The informal workshops are practical workshops which coaches will find useful to build on existing learning. It doesn't try to cover everything and the subject matter can be decided by the centre.

So.....Look at your Netball Calendar for the rest of the year and next year. Add in important Centre/Zone/National Dates applicable to your centre (utilise the Centre/zone/NNZ websites) and plan your Coach Development to suit your centre.

Complete the attached Coach Development Plan and return to your Coach Development Officer to lock in dates so your centre coaches don't miss out. If you are unsure of how to proceed, please don't hesitate to contact one of the Zone Coach Development staff to assist you.
