

Netball Waikato Bay of Plenty Performance Development Squad Level 1 Programme 2017:

Congratulations to all those named in the Waikato Bay of Plenty Zone Level 1 Development Squad for 2016/17. This group is the entry Development Squad for the Zone and is made up of around 70 emerging talented U17 netballers.

Selection into this squad has been made by the Zone Performance Manager and Zone Selectors over a number of weeks where athletes have been observed at U17s national tournament, Rotorua Zone Secondary School tournament or UNISS.

Our L1 Performance programme launch will be in Cambridge at St Peters School on Sunday November 6th. This will be the first workshop of a 7 session programme that starts in November and finishes on March 19th 2017.

Being a part of this programme will give athletes the opportunity to meet and learn alongside other top netballers, be coached by our top age group coaches and have an exclusive coaching session from some of our Magic and/or BEKO players.

The programme is outlined as follows:

<u>February 12th</u> Sunday. Session 2. Skills and game preparation for Talent ID Day on 19^{th} February.

<u>February 19th</u> Sunday. Session 3. Talent ID Day at QEII Stadium Tauranga. NZSS selectors will be invited to attend.

<u>February 26th</u> Sunday. Session 4. Skills and tactics in squads at centres.

March 5th Sunday. Session 5. Skills and tactics in squads at centres. Magic players to coach tbc.

March 12th Sunday. Session 6. Skills and tactics in squads at centres.

March 19th Sunday. Session 7. Squad tournament in Rotorua and Zone champion squad crowned.

As with many things today there is a cost to providing such programmes with high calibre personnel. In order to help meet the costs of delivery of this great opportunity Magic (Netball WBOP) Zone will be charging a registration fee of \$130 for the entire programme.

Fees will help cover the cost of gym and facility hireage, coach and coordinator remuneration, netball equipment, a 'Magic in the Making 2017' singlet and sports science nutritionist and strength & conditioning advice.
