

Year 3 & 4

Research findings (AUT 2013) showed 5 v 5 players were exposed to:

- more touches on the ball (50% more)
- more successful shots (one every 3.3 minutes compared with 8.9 minutes)
- Longer periods of play (94 seconds compared with 50 seconds)


